and Policies:	•The Competition Protocols and Procedures, posted throughout the facility, must be followed at all times
	•Deck changing is prohibited
	•The presence of cell phones, smart phones, iPads, etc. <u>anywhere</u> behind the starting blocks is prohibited at all times during competition
	 Violations of the AHISD meet filming policy, will result in termination of volunteer positions
	•Photographers and videographers are specifically prohibited from the area immediately behind the starting blocks during competition. Violators are subject to disqualification from the meet, dismissal from the facility or volunteer position and arrest
	 Parents and other spectators are not permitted on-deck at any time for any reason
	 Flash photography of <u>any sort</u> is expressly forbidden during competition
	 Standing in front of and / or leaning against the glass rails is expressly forbidden
	 Times noted on the scoreboard are never official and must not <u>ever</u> be regarded as such
	 All swimmers and divers are required to compete in appropriate school approved swimwear
	 Hats, body or face painting, costumes, and / or props will not be allowed
	•Organized cheers by school's teams will be allowed on deck in front of the designated seating area for each school
	•All spirit groups must stay in the spectator area and will not be allowed on deck; team mascots will be allowed on the pool deck
	 Athletes and / or teams that violate these rules will be subject to disciplinary actions that could include disqualification from the competition.

And Videos:	•Each participating school is allowed one photographer on deck during competition
	•In the event such personnel are present, parents or guardians of swimmers under the age of 18 who do not wish to
	have photos or videos of their athletes made, are required to contact the Meet Director prior to the beginning of warmups.
	•Photographers and videographers are prohibited from the area immediately behind the starting blocks and are also specifically prohibited from taking shots using flash during the start phase of <i>any</i> race. Violators are subject to
Media Deck	disqualification from the meet, dismissal from the facility and arrest.
Access:	•Access to the deck by the media is carefully controlled and members must check in with Norm Collins, the AHISD Aquatics Coordinator. By Wednesday, January 17, 2024, teams need to submit name of the media personnel for each school. Media passes will be limited to one per team. Filming for All American Diving Applications please check in with the Diving Administrator, Charly Collins, Wednesday, January 17, 2024, prior to the start of the meet.

	• If the swimmers are to be correctly noted in the Final Results, the order of swimming must also be specified.

PROHIBITED BAGS

- All purses, bags, and containers larger than a small clutch
- Backpacks
- Binocular Cases
- Briefcases or Computer Bags
- Camera Bags
- Coolers
- Fanny Packs
- Luggage

- **APPROVED BAGS**
- Clear Plastic, Vinyl, or PVC Totes not exceeding 12" by 6" by 12"
- Plastic Storage Bags (one gallon size)
- Small Clutch Purses approximately the size of your hand; no larger than 5.5" by 8.5" with or without strap or handle
