Starts:	<ul> <li>In the <u>preliminary</u> sessions ONLY, fly-over starts will be utilized for most <u>individual</u> events</li> <li>•Exceptions: 1000 and 500 Free / 400 I-M / Backstrokes / Relays</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>The purpose of fly-over starts is to conserve time and to establish and maintain meet momentum</li> <li>Under ideal conditions and with appropriate cooperation from the athletes, intervals between races can be held to a nominal 25 seconds</li> <li>The acaditions required:</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>The conditions required:         <ul> <li>As swimmers finish their race, they <u>MUST stay in the water</u> and close to the wall as the next heat is started over their heads</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>A failure to do so can create potentially dangerous situations</li> <li>As soon as the outgoing race is in the water – <u>but not before</u> - the just finished swimmers must promptly exit the pool</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>The procedure:</li> <li>When the finishing race is approximately five meters from the wall, the Deck Referee will sound the short whistles, which alerts the next heat to be immediately ready to mount the blocks</li> <li>When the last swimmer in the incoming heat is about to touch the wall, the Deck Referee will sound the long whistle and all swimmers <u>MUST</u> IMMEDIATELY mount the blocks and prepare for a start</li> <li>As soon as the Deck Referee is satisfied the pool is clear and all is in readiness, her / his arm will be extended and the Starter will give the "Take your mark" Command</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>The same process is then repeated for each additional heat</li> <li>Intervals between events are similarly managed, i.e., there will be no delays</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Because this procedure is time sensitive with few or no delays, upcoming swimmers must anticipate their next race, have caps and goggles in place, be properly situated behind their blocks and be immediately ready to mount the blocks on hearing the long whistle</li> <li>If careful attention is not given to the situation at hand, swimmers can very easily miss their race and / or be disqualified</li> </ul>

Diving:	<ul> <li>National Federation Rules will apply</li> <li>The Degree-of-Difficulty requirements for this meet are:</li> <li>Optionals - Minimum 12.8 for ONE METER - Voluntaries not to exceed 9.0 – National. Federation DD Table</li> </ul>
	Optionals -Minimum 12.1 for THREE METER - Voluntaries not to exceed 9.5 – Finals DD Table •Please note the daily schedule on page one (1) •Events will be 11-dive contests
	<ul> <li>Five (5) voluntary (one from each category)</li> <li>Six (6) optional dives (one from each category) <u>plus</u> one extra dive</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>All divers MUST be entered with their team via Hy-Tek Commlink File **<u>AND</u>**</li> <li>All divers MUST enter completed sheets via <u>www.cleanentries.com</u> by 1200, November 27th THERE CAN BE NO EXCEPTIONS!</li> </ul>

Regulations and Policies:	<ul> <li>Deck changing is prohibited</li> <li>Two-piece swim wear is prohibited</li> <li>The presence or use of cell phones, smart phones or any other devices capable of producing audio recordings, photographic or video images in locker rooms, restrooms or changing areas is strictly and specifically prohibited at all times.</li> <li>There are no exceptions to this policy.</li> <li>Violators are subject to disqualification from the meet and disbarment from the facility</li> <li>The presence of cell phones, smart phones, iPads, etc. <u>anywhere</u> behind the starting blocks is prohibited at all times during competition</li> <li>Violators are subject to having their devices temporarily confiscated</li> <li>Photographers and videographers are specifically prohibited from the area immediately behind the starting blocks, which includes the area normally occupied by the Deck Referee, Starter and sometimes other officials</li> <li>Parents and other spectators are not permitted on-deck at any time for any reason</li> <li>Flash photography of any sort is expressly forbidden during competition</li> <li>Standing in front of and / or leaning against the glass rails in the Davis Pool is expressly forbidden</li> <li>Fliming in the Davis Pool may only be accomplished from the blue-rail areas behind the diving boards</li> <li>Times noted on the scoreboards are never official and must not ever be regarded as such</li> <li>Spectators may not bring food or drink into the facilities</li> </ul>

National Time Verification:	<ul> <li>•This meet has been Approved for Observation by USA Swimming for NTV purposes</li> <li>•Times achieved by swimmers who are <u>currently</u> and properly registered with USA Swimming, have an accurate and complete USA Swimming ID Number and SWIMS -associated name in the Meet Manager Database and conform to the Technical Rules will be loaded into the SWIMS Database <ul> <li>Please review the document on page ten (10).</li> </ul> </li> <li>•Observation of all events involving the backstroke, including lead-off splits in the medley relays, will be accomplished "by exception" as all deck officials will be certified by at least one LSC and USA Swimming <ul> <li>No other action in this regard will be required of either coaches or athletes</li> </ul> </li> <li>•If required, additional information will be provided at the coaches' meeting</li> <li>•However, <u>coaches / athletes</u> must ensure swimmer's complete, accurate and valid USA Swimming ID Numbers and full names are in the Meet Manager Database prior to the conclusion of the meet if loading of times into the USA Swimming SWIMS Database is desired <ul> <li>•The necessary data are easily available from athlete's USA Swimming ID Card</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
Breaks:	<ul> <li>A 15-minute break, required by Rule, after the 50-yard freestyle in both <u>preliminaries and finals</u></li> <li>A five-minute break will be taken after the 100-yard Individual Medley in both <u>preliminaries and finals</u>.</li> </ul>
Team Manager:	<ul> <li>An HYV File containing the complete meet setup, including qualifying times, will be available for download into Team Manager on the das Schwimmen San Antonio Web Site at www.aaaa-sa.org</li> <li>It will be to each individual swimmer's significant advantage if legal names, dates of birth and proper USA Swimming ID Numbers, if applicable; are included in the participating Team Manager Databases</li> </ul>

Restrictions:	<ul> <li>This meet is open to <u>ALL</u> public and private high schools from within and without the State of Texas</li> <li>Only one relay team per school may enter each relay event</li> <li>An individual swimming competitor is permitted to enter a maximum of four (4) <u>High School</u> events <u>per day</u>, no more than two (2) of which may be individual events</li> <li>An individual swimming competitor is permitted to enter a maximum of five (5) <u>Senior events per day</u>, no more than three (3) of which may be individual events</li> <li>Individual swimmers must meet the minimum qualifying time standards on page eight (8)</li> <li>In general, this is a proof-of-time meet</li> <li>For eligibility purposes this meet is regarded as two separate meets held in conjunction with one another over a two-day period</li> <li>Under UIL Rules this meet is counted as two of the annually allotted invitational meets</li> </ul>
Relays:	<ul> <li>•Minimum <u>relay</u> qualifying times (page seven [7]) must have been achieved subsequent to <u>September 1, 2023</u></li> <li>•<u>Relay only</u> swimmers <u>ARE</u> permitted</li> <li>•Only the four (4) swimmers declared on the front of the relay card are permitted to report to the blocks and compete</li> <li>•If relay swimmers are to be correctly noted in the Final Results, the order of swimming must also be specified</li> <li>•Relay cards for the preliminary* 200-yard Medley Relay must be turned in to the Official Scorer not later than the beginning of the coaches' meeting</li> <li>•Relay cards for the preliminary* 200-yard Free Relay must be turned in to the Official Scorer not later than the start of the 500-yard Freestyles</li> <li>Relay cards for the preliminary* 800-yard Free Relay must be turned in to the Official Scorer not later than the start of the 50-yard Backstrokes</li> <li>•Relay cards for the preliminary* 400-yard Free Relay must be turned in to the Official Scorer not later than the start of the 100-yard breaststrokes</li> <li>•Once relay cards have been turned in to the Official Scorer, <u>no name changes will be permitted</u></li> <li>•Designation of the lead-off swimmer may be altered up until the swimmers report to the blocks</li> <li>•Post-meet corrections or alterations cannot be made</li> <li>•For the finals* session, if there is no change in the order of swimmers or the makeup of a relay team, the Official Scorer will NOT require a new card be submitted</li> <li>•For the finals* session, if there is a change in <b>either</b> the order of the swimmers or the makeup of a relay team a NEW card must be prepared and submitted to the Official Scorer as noted above.</li> <li>*In cases where there are eight (8) or fewer entries for any relay event, it will be contested as a timed final in the finals session only and <u>NOT</u> swum in preliminaries – the card submission restrictions noted above will, however, still apply</li> </ul>

Times:	<ul> <li>Individual swimmers must be entered with previously achieved, provable seed times in short course yards only</li> <li>Entries with no time (NT) <u>WILL NOT</u> be accepted and any entry fees submitted will not be refunded</li> <li>Times converted from long or short course meters are <u>NOT</u> acceptable</li> <li>Relay teams <u>must</u> enter with a seed time and conform to the minimum qualifying times on page seven (7)</li> <li>Relay qualifying times may be of an actual team or in the aggregate</li> <li>Relay qualifying times must have been achieved <u>subsequent</u> to September 1, 2023</li> </ul>
Proof	
of Time:	<ul> <li><u>All</u> entries are subject to proof-of time</li> <li>The only acceptable sources for proof-of-time are: <ul> <li>USA Swimming National SWIMS Database</li> <li>AAAA Results Archives</li> <li>Specific Team manager Proof-of-Time Reports</li> </ul> </li> <li>Teams with swimmers who fail to swim at least their entered times will be reported in writing to their school's principal and they may be denied entry to this meet in future years</li> </ul>

•In cases where the proof-of-time verification process fails to prove the time, the athlete will not be entered into the event and any entry fees submitted will not be refunded



#### Qualifying Times and Proof-of-Time:

Individual swimmers and relay teams may enter this meet <u>ONLY</u> if they have at some time (Lifetime best) achieved the qualifying time listed in the Order of Events on page seven (7) for each event entered.
There are no "free" or "bonus" events

•Swimmers who enter into and / or compete in events for which they have not achieved the qualifying time are therefore ineligible for further competition, previous exceptions noted

•Any team which suffers four (4) or more failures to prove the minimum individual event qualifying time will be banned from participation in future South Zone TISCA Championship meets

•In addition, the Principal of the offending school will be notified in writing of the matter

## Scratch Rules:

#### Coaches: Please review these Scratch Rules carefully!

#### •Pre-Meet:

•Please report all known pre-meet scratches to the Entries Chair within 24 hours of the Psych Sheet being posted •That deadline will be noted in the Psych Sheet

•Accuracy of the Heat Sheets cannot be ensured and entry fees will not be refunded if this time constraint is not met

#### •<u>General</u>:

- •There will be no penalty for scratching (no show) from any pre-seeded preliminary event
- •No shows in each of the finals sessions will be penalized per rule and as noted below

•The 1000-yard freestyle will be seeded on deck (not pre-seeded) and competitors who checked in (by 0930 on the day of the event, and then fail to appear for their race will be barred from further competition in the meet, illness and injury excepted

#### •For Finals Qualifiers:

•USA Swimming Championship Scratch Rules will prevail and the 30 minute rule will be observed, i. e. after the official announcement and / or posting of the results of any given preliminary event have been made, individual competitors and relay teams who qualify for the finals in <u>Friday's</u> events must scratch with the Official Scorer within 30 minutes of that announcement / posting, OR they must compete in the finals session under penalty of disqualification from further participation in the meet

•Failures to compete by reason of illness or injury are excepted, as are alternates

Swimmers and relay teams who qualify for finals events on <u>Saturday</u>, fail to scratch within the 30-minute time limit and subsequently fail to appear for competition <u>will be stripped of all points and awards</u>, including those awarded to any relay team(s) on which an offending swimmer may have participated.
In addition, their school's Principal will be notified in writing of the incident
Failures to compete by reason of illness or injury are excepted, as are alternates

#### Alternates:

•Swimmers who may qualify as alternates for final events and wish to compete should no shows occur, must be within an area previously designated by the Meet Referee and be immediately available

•Immediately is defined as being in the area designated by the Meet Referee, properly attired, at the block, and ready to swim within 30 seconds of being called

# HIGH SCHOOL COACHES and ADMINISTRATORS, PLEASE NOTE!

USA Swimming (USA-S) has made significant revisions to its registration process, which in turn have made changes to the National Time Verification (NTV) program necessary. These revisions of policy and procedure directly effect how certain times from high school competition are permitted to be entered into the National SWIMS Database.

Many, if not most of you, have one or more Club swimmers who are, or should be; registered members of USA-S on your High School Team. Each such athlete, by rule and policy, is ostensibly registered with USA-S for the current year. As proof of that registration, each will have a USA-S Identification (ID) card containing information related to the NTV Program about which you need to be familiar.

The important revisions to USA-S registration include, but are not limited to, the following:

•Parents and guardians are now required create USA-S accounts for athletes and may enter the athlete's name in whatever fashion desired.

•Birth Certificates are no longer checked for "full legal name," so a nickname, the last name they use, etc. are now acceptable, e.g., swimmer's "legal" name may be John William Hernandez-Smith but the swimmer goes by Jack Hernandez and the latter is what can now be entered as <u>the</u> name on the USAS side.

•That is also the name high school coaches <u>must</u> now use. On the other hand, if a full legal name was entered, then the high school coach must use it.

•It is imperative that the name in the high school database perfectly matches what is in SWIMS, including the middle initial.

•Consequently, PLEASE <u>do not</u> use "full legal names" any longer as there is no guarantee the swimmer's full legal name is in SWIMS.

•The date of birth and gender must be included

• The correct USAS ID must also be included. The USAS ID is now 14 random, alphanumeric characters. SWIMS will not recognize the older IDs (6 digits followed by 8 characters).

•Athletes must be a member of USA-S in good standing as of the meet start date for the times from observed meets to be loaded to the SWIMS database.

•For athlete members ages 18 and older, a current Athlete Protection Training (APT) is also required.

•Effective September 9, 2023; South Texas Swimming may no longer go back and load times achieved at observed meets by swimmers who were <u>not</u> members of USAS in good standing as of the observed meet's start date even if they later register with USA-S, renew an expired membership, and complete the APT if applicable.

SWIMS Users always endeavor to match athletes to times that will not load, but it is generally unknown if the mismatch is because of the name, birth date or if the athlete is not currently registered. When there is <u>complete and correct</u> data in the high school database, SWIMS Users can almost always match athletes easily.
