SWIMMING: Meet Format:

- Championship meet format (prelim/finals)
 - o A/B Final for Individual & Relays, seeded by time and gender, slowest to fastest
 - The host reserves the right to configure the sessions as may be required once all entries have been received
- See order of events on page five(5)
- Preliminary Session will be seeded by time and gender, slowest to fastest
- Preliminary Session may be run in one or two 10 lane pools utilizing Fly-over starts
 - o If two (2) pools are utilized, odd heats will compete in the South pool and even heats in the North pool.
- Finals will be run in one 8 lane pool and swim slowest to fastest
 - **DIVING:**
- Diving will consist of Eleven (11) dives:
 - Five (5) Voluntary dives and six (6) Optional Dives.
 - Voluntaries not to exceed 9.0 National Federation DD table
 - Five (5) voluntary dives one from each category
 - Six (6) optional dives one from each category plus one extra dive

- **Entry Restrictions:** Each contestant may enter a maximum of four (4) events.
 - No more than two (2) may be individual events.
 - In accordance with UIL rules, there will be no exhibition swims or dives in the meet.
 - Relay swimmer limits will be strictly enforced. Moving individuals from one relay to another within the same event # is not allowed. Exhibition swims or dives will not be allowed
 - Please use the official UIL Team Code and use the NUMERIC grade
 - All divers MUST be entered into Meet Manager with their teams

- Entry Procedures: Entries may be made only via Hy-Tek commlink file
 - Entries will be accepted only via email or hand-delivery
 - Hand-written entries will not be accepted
 - Entries should be emailed to entry chair: neatentries@gmail.com
 - Please rename the commlink file to clearly identify the entering team
 - Do not assume your entries have been received without confirmation
 - Entries should include entry fee report and appropriate proof of time documentation

Qualifying Times: • Swimmers who enter into and/or compete in events for which they have not met the qualifying time standard may be ineligible for further competition

- **Awards:** Team awards will be given to the top two (2) Girl's Teams and the top two (2) Boy's Teams.
 - Medals will be awarded to first, second and third places in Individual and Relay events.
 - Ribbons will be awarded for fourth through eighth places

Rules: • U.I.L. and National Federation rules will govern the meet.

- Deck Changing is prohibited.
- Two-piece swim wear is prohibited at any time
- The presence or use of cell phones, smart phones, or any other devices capable of producing audio, photographic or video recordings in locker rooms, restrooms, or changing areas is strictly prohibited.
- Parents and other spectators are not permitted on-deck at any time.
- No flash photography allowed during swimming/ diving events.
- No folding chairs.

Swimming Scratch

Please send any pre-meet scratches to the entry chair

Rules:

- There is no penalty for scratching (no show) from a pre-seeded preliminary event
- For Finals Qualifies, after the official announcement and/or posting of the results of any preliminary event have been make, individual competitors who qualify for finals must scratch with the admin official within 30 minutes of that announcement/posting or they must compete in the finals session under the penalty of disqualification from further participation in the meet.
- Swimmers and relay teams who qualify for finals events and fail to scratch will be stripped of all points and awards, including those awarded to any relay time (s) on which an offending swimmer may have participated. In addition, their school's Principal will be notified in writing of the incident.
- Athletes who qualify as alternates for final events and wish to compete should a no show occur, must be within an area previously designated by the Meet Referee and be immediately available.
- There is no penalty for alternates who fail to report.

Medical Supervision: ● During the meet lifeguards will be present to provide any necessary medical supervision and treatment for athletes participating in the meet.

Swimmer • No team or parent photographers will be allowed on deck.

- Photographs and In the event such media personnel are present, parents or guardians of swimmers under the age of 18 who do not wish to have photos or videos of their athletes made, are required to contact the Meet Director prior to the beginning of warm-ups.
 - Media photographers and videographers are prohibited from the area immediately behind the starting blocks.

Clear Bag Policy: ● See the NEISD Clear Bag Policy graphic on page four(4).

Restrictions:

- **Cell Phone** The presence and/or use of cell phones, smartphones, or any other devices capable of producing audio recordings and/or photographic or video images in locker rooms, restrooms, or changing areas is strictly and specifically prohibited at all times.
 - There are no exceptions to this prohibition.
 - Violators are subject to disqualification from the meet, disbarment from the facility and arrest.

- Officials: All currently registered High School Swimming and Dive officials are invited.
 - Officials should notify the Meet Referee of their intentions and availability.
 - The uniform for Prelims is white collared shirts or blouses over khaki trousers, bermuda-length shorts, skirts, or capris. No short shorts, jeans, or flip-flops.
 - The uniform for Finals is blue collared shirts or blouses over khaki trousers or skirts. (no shorts, jeans, or flip-flops).
 - Please report to the meet referee in the upstairs Walker Conference Room.

Timers: ● Each team must provide 2 timers each day

 - Concession stand will be available.
