Swimming Format:

- High School Swimming Championship format
 - The host reserves the right to configure the sessions as may be required once all entries have been received
- See order of events on page four (4)
- Preliminary Session will be seeded by time and gender, slowest to fastest without regard to UIL classification
- Preliminary Session may be run in one or two 10 lane pools utilizing Fly-over starts
 - If two (2) pools are utilized, odd heats will compete in the South pool and even heats in the North pool.
- Finals will be run in one 8 lane pool
- Consolation and Championship Heats for all individual events except 500-yard Freestyle
- Championship Heats only for all relays and 500-yard Freestyle
- Finals will be seeded and scored by Division (UIL Classification)
 - UIL Class 5A (including all 4A and under and private schools)
 - UIL Class 6A
- Relay cards for the 200-yard medley relay must be turned in to the Admin no later than thirty (30) minutes prior to the start of the meet.
- Relay cards for the 200-yard Free Relay must be turned in to the Admin no later than the start of the men's 500-yard freestyle.
- Relay cards for the 400-yard Free Relay must be turned in to the Admin no later than the start of the men's 100-yard backstroke

Diving Format

- Friday: 1 Meter And Saturday: 3 Meter Josh Davis Natatorium
- National Federation Rules will apply
- One-meter (11 dives) and Three Meter (6 dives)
- Degree of Difficulty (DD) requirements:
 - One Meter (11 Dives)
 - Optionals: Minimum DD 12.0
 - Volunaries: DD Not to exceed 9.0 National Federation DD Table
 - Five (5) voluntary dives one from each category
 - Six (6) optional dives one from each category plus one extra dive
 - Three Meter (6 Dives)
 - Optionals: Minimum DD 10.0
 - Volunaries: DD Not to exceed 2.0 National Federation DD Table
 - One (1) Voluntary
 - Five (5) Optional
- All divers MUST be entered into Meet Manager with their teams
- All divers MUST submit completed Dive Sheets via <u>www.cleanentries.com</u> by 12:00 pm, October 28, 2024
- All corrections, revisions, additions, deletions, etc. must be completed in writing and in the hand of the Diving Referee no later than one-hour before the start of competition

Entry Restrictions:

- Special Note: This meet will be scored by Division (UIL Classification), therefore it is imperative Teams
 UIL Class (5A/ 6A) be included with entries. All 4A and under and private schools please designate 5A
 class.
- Only one (1) relay team per school may be entered in each relay event
- An individual swimming competitor is permitted to enter a maximum of four (4) events per day, no more than two (2) of which may be individual events
- Each participating school/team may enter a maximum of six (6) athletes in the 50-yard events and a maximum of four (4) athletes in all 100, 200, or 500-yard events.
- Entries with no time (NT) WILL NOT be accepted

Entry Procedures:

- Entries may be made only via Hy-Tek commlink file
- Entries will be accepted only via email or hand-delivery
- Hand-written entries will not be accepted
- Entries should be emailed to entry chair: neatentries@gmail.com
- Please rename the commlink file to clearly identify the entering team
- Do not assume your entries have been received without confirmation
- Entries should include entry fee report and appropriate proof of time documentation

Qualifying Times:

 There are no qualifying times for this meet but teams must adhere to the team and individual entry limits

Rules:

- Deck Changing is prohibited
- Two-piece swim wear is prohibited at any time
- Please review the graphic on page five (5) regarding bags, purses, and back-packs
- Parents and other spectators are not permitted on-deck at any time for any reason
- Flash photography of any sort is expressly forbidden at any time during competition
- Standing in front of and/or leaning against the glass rails is expressly forbidden
- Times noted on scoreboard are never officials and must not ever be regarded as such
- The presence and/or use of cell phones, smartphones, or any other devices capable of producing audio recordings and/or photographic or video images in locker rooms, restrooms, or changing areas is strictly and specifically prohibited at all times. There are no exceptions to this prohibition.
- The presence of cell phones, smartphones, iPads, etc. anywhere behind the starting blocks is prohibited at all times during competition.
- Violators are subject to disqualification from the meet, disbarment from the facility and arrest.

Swimming Scratch Rules:

- Please send any pre-meet scratches to the entry chair
- There is no penalty for scratching (no show) from a pre-seeded preliminary event
- For Finals Qualifies, after the official announcement and/or posting of the results of any preliminary event have been make, individual competitors who qualify for finals must scratch with the admin official within 30 minutes of that announcement/posting or they must compete in the finals session under the penalty of disqualification from further participation in the meet.
- Swimmers and relay teams who qualify for finals events and fail to scratch will be stripped of all points and awards, including those awarded to any relay time (s) on which an offending swimmer may have participated. In addition, their school's Principal will be notified in writing of the incident.
- Athletes who qualify as alternates for final events and wish to compete should a no show occur, must be within an area previously designated by the Meet Referee and be immediately available.
- There is no penalty for alternates who fail to report.

Clear Bag Policy: National Time Verification:

- See the NEISD Clear Bag Policy graphic on page five (5).
- This meet has been approved for observation by USA Swimming for National Time Verification (NTV)
 purposes
- Times for USA Swimming Athletes in good standing as of the meet date(s) will be uploaded automatically to the USA Swimming database when the athlete's first and last names, middle initial, gender, date of birth and USA Swimming ID are submitted. Please note, the USA Swimming ID is now 14 random alphanumeric characters.
- It is the responsibility of the athlete to provide the high school coach with the correct information so that it can be included with the athlete's entries

Officials:

- All currently registered High School Swimming and Dive officials are invited.
- Officials should notify the Meet Referee of their intentions and availability.
- The uniform for Prelims (Friday) is white collared shirts or blouses over khaki trousers, bermuda-length shorts, skirts, or capris. No short shorts, jeans, or flip-flops.
- The uniform for Finals (Saturday) is Blue collared shirts or blouses over khaki trousers or skirts. (no shorts, jeans, or flip-flops).
- Please report to the meet referee in the upstairs Walker Conference Room.

Timers:

- Each team will be expected to provide volunteer timers based on the team size.
- Timer assignments will be emailed out prior to the meet by the entry chair.

Notes:

Buses are required to unload and reload their athletes at the front doors of the Davis Natatorium and must park in the soccer parking lot behind the pool.

SMALL CLUTCH PURSE

Approximately the size of your hand, but absolutely no larger than 5.5" x 8.5" (see our small guide sheet) with or without a handle or strap. Can be carried separately or within an approved plastic bag shown above.



- Exceptions will be made for: Bags for medically necessary items
 - News media equipment (for credentialed media)
 - Official team and other field photographers
 - Booster clubs selling items
 - Diaper bags

All bags are subject to inspection prior to entry regardless of size or type.
