And Videos: •There may be one or more photographers and / or videographers on deck at this meet.
•In the event such personnel are present, parents or guardians of swimmers under the age of 18 who do not wish to have photos or videos of their athletes made, are required to contact the Meet Director prior to the beginning of warm-ups.

Meet Format:

- High School Teams competing in pre-seeded timed final competition
- Standard and modified high school individual events, i.e., **NO** relays
- Maximum (slower than) times for all events and Minimum (faster than) qualifying times for six (6) events
- The Federation Whistle Start Procedure will be in use
- The Federation No-recall False Start Procedure will be in use
- Order of events and Time Standards on page four (4)
- Fly-over starts will be used, except for the backstroke events
- Breaks will be taken only at the points noted in the Order of Events on page four (4)

Entry

Restrictions: •This meet is open to all public and private high school teams who are members of the AAHSSL.
•Individual swimmers may enter a maximum of four (4) events
•No limit on the number of individual entries per team
•ENTRIES RECEIVED WITHOUT A SEED TIME WILL NOT BE ENTERED INTO THE MEET

Qualifying

Times: •There are minimum qualifying times on six (6) events, three girls and three boys, please see page four (4)
•Swimmers must have at some time (lifetime best) achieved the minimum cut-off time for each of those events they choose to enter.
•Entry times may be challenged

- If a challenge results in an entry time being declared invalid, the swimmer will be disqualified from further participation in the meet

•Any team accumulating three (3) invalid entries will be banned from further participation in the meet and their school's principal notified



- Facility:**
- Ten FINA-width (2.75-meters) lanes
 - 0.75-meter buffers outside lanes zero and nine
 - All automatic starting and timing
 - Full, real-time scoreboard with heat and event display
 - Off-deck seating for 800
 - Spectators and non-participating athletes are not permitted on deck.
 - Concessions and swim shop in the lobby
 - Spectators may not bring food or drink into the facilities
- Water Depth** ↓:
- One-meter from start end 2.35m (7.7ft)
 - One-meter from turn end 1.77m (5.8ft)
 - Five-meters from start end 2.41m (7.9ft)
 - Five-meters from turn end 1.77m (5.8ft)
- Rules:**
- The 2023 - 2024 National Federation of State High School Association Swimming and Diving Rules will apply
 - Swimmers will not be considered to be officially entered into the meet until actually stepping up on the starting platform or into the water, i.e., there will be no penalty for scratches or no-shows.
 - Nominal interval of 30 seconds between races
- Entry Procedures:**
- Entries may be made ONLY via HY-TEK Commlink File – e-mailed or hand-delivered
 - Hard copy *MUST* accompany
 - An “HYV” File for Team Manager is available at www.aaaa-sa.org OR www.alamoaquatics.com
- E-Mail Entries:**
- You must submit your entries via e-mail or hand delivered to: Cory Bolleter at: cbolle@neisd.net
 - The Commlink File must be *renamed* to clearly identify the entering team, the shorter the better
 - Athletes included in improperly identified Commlink Files (Cfile0X.cl2 or zfile00X.zip) will not be entered into the meet and any entry fees will not be refunded
 - Athletes WILL NOT be entered into the Meet Manager Database until the Meet Entry Report (hard copy) is received as an attachment to the e-mail or hand-delivered and all fees are paid.
 - Under no circumstances will entries be accepted via FAX
 - Please do not assume your entries have been received without confirmation

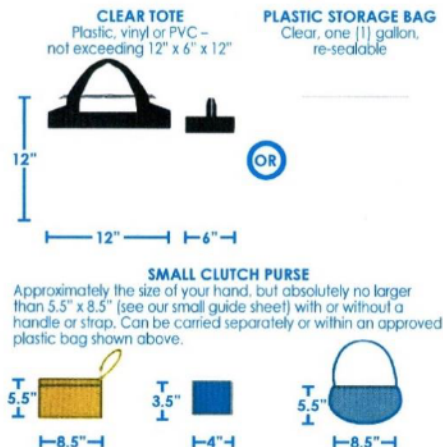
Prohibited Bags
