- Diving Begins right after the swimming races are completed/pool changed

HOSPITALITY:

There will be hospitality for all Coaches and Officials in the pool area by the diving blocks. Complimentary coffee is available for everyone in the Lobby area of the YMCA.

POOLS:

The competition will take place in the eight (8) lanes of our 25 yard indoor pool. Warm up will take place in the 25 yard pool before the meet, in assigned lanes. There is no diving allowed in the shallow pool. Open warm up/ cool down is permissible during the meet in the shallow indoor therapeutic pool. Note this is a heated pool, use your best judgment.

ENTRIES: All entries must be sent electronically via email using Hy-Tek Meet/Team Manager computer software or emailed spreadsheet for smaller teams without the Hy-Tek Meet/Team Manager Software. This includes team relays and individual events. **Please include a paper copy of your entries for us to double check that everything carried over correctly between softwares.**

- There are no limitations on the number of swimmers per individual event, however only the four (4) competitors from each team may score points for any given event.
- Each athlete may enter a maximum of four (4) events of which no more than two (2) events may be individual events.
- Teams may enter only 2 relays, please number relays A and B.

ENTRY FEES:

-Entry fees are \$12 per athlete(Swimmer or Diver) and \$6 per relay entered in the meet. Entry fees are due at the start of the competition.

AWARDS: There will be medals & ribbons for individuals & relay up to 10th place at this meet.

ORDER OF EVENTS:

Standard high school order of events will be followed, with the exception of diving. Diving will take place after all the swimming races are completed. There will be 5 minute breaks after the 200 Medley Relay, a 15 minute break after the 50 Freestyle events, and 5 minutes after the 100 Breaststroke events. The diving setup will take about 20-30 minutes to change over the pool.

RULES AND SANCTIONS:

The 2023-2024 National Federation of State High School Associations Swimming and Diving and all UIL rules and guidelines will be applied. Pending official availability, this meet MAY be USA swimming observed for registered USA swimmers. Please be sure that USA swimming IDs are correct in the Hy-Tek entry file.

TIMING SYSTEM:

A colorado electronic timing system with Daktronics electronic scoreboard will be used to time the meet. Two watches per lane will be used as back up. This meet will be available on Meet Mobile with free heat sheets.

TIMERS/VOLUNTEERS: We ask that each team submits **4 timers and or volunteers** for the meet. Should there be any open timing or volunteer positions, visiting teams may be asked to provide more than 4 volunteers.

SPECTATORS:

Spectators are permitted to attend. Entry fee for spectators will be \$3 per adult/child and \$2 per student with their ID. Heat Sheets will be sold at the door for \$2. Parking is limited at the YMCA and will be available on a first come, first serve basis. Masks are not required, and we ask that you self-monitor for any illness or symptoms.

AUDIO/VIDEO RECORDING DEVICES:

Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in the area behind the starting blocks, in changing areas, restrooms, showers, or locker rooms. Violators may be reported to law enforcement or other governmental authorities and/or may be barred from the facility during the sanctioned event.

ATHLETES/TEAM WAITING AREA:

- Teams are asked to enter from the back, where buses park. Upon entry, the gym is located to the right. Your team will have a sign designating your spot. Please make your swimmers aware that all equipment, including: bleachers, basketball hoops, and athletic equipment are property of the Hill Country YMCA. Usage of YMCA property is strictly prohibited. Please ensure a coach checks in, and enforces these expectations. YMCA staff will report any violations directly to coaches.
- A 'P.A.' system will be utilized to announce events and heats. Swimmers need to be aware of announcements, so as to report directly to the pool when necessary. The therapeutic pool is available for warm up. If a swimmer misses a race, make ups are unavailable due to the volume of this meet.
- All teams are required to keep your designated area clean, and free of spills. Sport drink spills need to be cleaned appropriately. Please keep in mind, we are all guests of the facility.

DECK CHANGING PROHIBITION:

Changing in or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is prohibited. Athletes will have access to changing rooms, showers, and restrooms at the YMCA.

CONCESSIONS:

Concessions will be available for anyone attending the meet located in the lobby area of the YMCA for purchase. Coffee is complimentary.
